

Oakland Firesafe Council Survey Highlights Challenges That Still Remain with Inspections of Private/Public Properties in Oakland Hills

For years, the official results of inspections on private properties in Oakland's high fire severity zone reported 95% or higher compliance with defensible space requirements, despite reports from residents that far fewer properties seemed to be compliance. Late in July and in early September of this year, the Oakland Firesafe Council observed a sample of properties within District 1 and District 4 in what had been the Wildfire Prevention Assessment District (WPAD). The survey revealed that there still is a disconnect between the City's defensible space requirements and the reality of compliance on both private and public properties.

This report highlights some of the ongoing issues facing the City of Oakland in inspecting public and private properties to reduce fire risk in the Oakland Hills. The drive-by survey focused on what could be seen from the street, and used the City's and State's Fire Code regulations as the criteria for assessment.

This unofficial sampling revealed that in District 1 (Warren Freeway to Grizzly Peak, Broadway Terrace to Claremont Canyon), one in three private properties and about half of the public properties were out of compliance as of July 31. In District 4, of the properties along Paso Robles, Balboa, Shepherd Canyon Road, Sayre, Saroni, Homeglen, Homewood, Glencourt, Arrowhead, East, West, Southwood, Manzanita, Villanova, and Skyline from Colton and Shepherd Canyon Park between 10 and 15% of the properties were observed as out of compliance with the City's defensible space regulations. It was much higher on the following streets in District 4:

The District 4 observations were made during the first week of September, 2017.



Unresolved Inspection Issues

- invasive ivy is widespread and hides a lot of dead debris; Many homes have ivy and other invasive overgrown bushes like cotoneaster and pampas grass that are clearly not cultivated nor is it irrigated landscaping
- Dead grass, thistle, broom, low lying and dead branches on trees and/or on the ground
- Parked cars on narrow streets are a problem
- Intersections are often overgrown corners, not buildable lots
- Tree limbs touch structures or the ground
- Substantial quantities of fire-prone vegetation on many of the public open space
 properties that have not been effectively maintained this year and often not been
 maintained for a number of years. The fire-prone invasives are thriving and
 spreading around both fire-prone trees in North Oakland, and along many roadside
 areas along streets and in parks and major open space locations.
- Some active homeless encampments on Caltrans properties near the PG&E substation and also west of Tunnel Road on Hwy. 13 near the Oakland/Berkeley line.

While information about the specific properties has been presented to the Fire Prevention Bureau of the Oakland Fire Department for follow up, the Oakland Firesafe Council presents this report to the Public Safety Committee for their consideration of the broader structural issues that result in so many properties still being out of compliance at the start of high fire season.

Broader Systemic Issues with Inspection Impact Effectiveness and Timeliness

For years, the Oakland Fire Department has been reporting that 95%-99% of the private properties within the City's high fire severity zone comply with the fire code by the end of the fire season. A number of residents in the area questioned how serious the City was about enforcing the fire code, when the reality looked so different from what was reported. While the Fire Department continues to work on strengthening its inspection and enforcement process, even this year--13 years after the formation of the Wildfire Prevention Assessment District and 26 years after the 1991 Oakland Hills Firestorm--there are still far too many properties out of compliance.

If the properties in question were originally passed during the first round of inspections by the station fire crews, then the issue for the city is the quality of the training and the monitoring of the fire crews who are tasked with the initial inspections. We do not know if that is the case and hope that the Public Safety Committee will ask OFD to further investigate this so that they can develop additional measures to improve the quality of initial inspections.



On the other hand, if the majority of these properties were NOT passed initially and were still awaiting the second or third inspections, this raises an entirely different set of issues:

- 1. The need to better educate the public about their responsibilities and to provide incentives so that they keep their properties maintained and in compliance with the fire code 365 days a year. Given the high numbers of noncompliance—and delays in bringing properties into compliance—too many property owners still do not understand that it is THEIR responsibility to keep their property up to code at all times, whether or not their property is inspected. There needs to be a comprehensive outreach/education plan—beyond the one mailer in the spring—to lay the foundation for changing behavior and increasing defensible space.
- 2. Analysis of the barriers to why the follow up inspections are so slow or non existent. We believe there are several challenges that contribute to this situation:
 - A. The ongoing shortage of qualified, experienced Vegetation Management inspection staff due to VM inspectors leaving for higher paying positions within OFD or elsewhere. This year the Vegetation Management Unit had 7 people vacate the 3 full time and 1 part time positions between January and September. Without sufficient staff, the fire inspectors have been hard pressed to keep up with their responsibilities, resulting in delays in contracting, inspections of vacant properties and follow up (3rd round) inspections in Districts 1, 6 & 7.
 - B. **Delays in the hiring process** due to massive unfilled positions throughout the City creating a tremendous backlog in Human Resources.
 - C. A need to find an alternative system to accommodate the ups and downs in filled positions. It is understood that encouraging employees to progress in their careers is desirable, but there needs to be a system for backfilling these positions as quickly as possible. One option is to dually train all fire inspectors in both building and vegetation management inspection, and then assigning them to one or the other responsibilities as needed. That would require a Classification Study and new job description, possibly eliminating the distinction between Vegetation Management Inspector and Commercial/Fire Code Inspectors so that the positions could be interchangeable.
 - D. Another issue is **the City's due process schedule for holding property owners accountable**. On paper, a noncompliant owner is given 30 days to bring the property into compliance. If still not in compliance after the second inspection, the property owner has another 15 days to do so. After that, the City can elect to clear the property itself and charge the property owner or put a lien on the property. However, with only \$100,000 budgeted in the General Fund for private property clean up, only a handful of properties are managed this way. And liens will only be collected when properties sell. The City needs to look not only at the due process schedule but also at other ways to receive reimbursement for their expenses.



Recommendations

- 1. Given these issues, it seems prudent for the City to survey other jurisdictions in the area to see how they organize their vegetation management inspections (within Fire Department, Code Compliance or other), how they manage their inspections and their city-owned property clearance, and how they recover clearance costs when the property owner isn't taking responsibility for clearing the property.
- 2. Initiate a Classification Study for Vegetation Management Inspectors, and/or revamp the entire Inspection Unit for OFD to make commercial and vegetation management inspectors interchangeable in duties with the same salaries to stem the ongoing turnaround in staffing among Vegetation Management Inspectors.
- 3. Fill the full time Vegetation Management Inspector positions as quickly as possible—certainly before the start of the New Year so that the unit is trained and ready to roll before the start of the 2018 Fire Season.
- 4. Develop an alternative system for staffing the Vegetation Management Unit when workload is at its highest.
- 5. Review the City's due process schedule for holding property owners accountable. Take best practices from other jurisdictions and adapt to Oakland.
- 6. Develop and Fund an ongoing public education, outreach and incentive program to reinforce property owner's understanding of their responsibilities to maintain defensible space 365 days a year.

We urge members of the Public Safety Committee to ask the Oakland Fire Department and the City Administrator's Office to delve into the specifics of the attached data, and provide a report on what they learned from their further assessment, a report on how other jurisdictions handle these functions, and recommendations on how Oakland can improve its wildfire inspection process and implementation. This information is critical, not only in the short term, but also as the City moves forward with implementing the 10-year Vegetation Management Plan now in development. Public support of another vegetation management initiative is highly dependent on residents' perceptions of how well the city is inspecting properties within the high fire severity zone, as well as how well the city is maintaining its own properties.

The Oakland Firesafe Council is a non-profit community based organization focused on education and outreach to reduce the risk of wildfires in Oakland. Its members are former members of the WPAD advisory committee and leaders of the Oakland Wildland Stewards (OWLS), volunteers who help maintain many of Oakland's parks and open spaces in the fire prone hills.


