GENASYS PROTECT (ZONEHAVEN)





Genasys Protect (**protect.genasys.com**), formerly Zonehaven AWARE, is a commercial software application designed to help first responders manage evacuations


during an emergency such as a wildfire or flood. It will also help inform communities of these threats, and when and how to evacuate, shelter-in-place and return. Genasys Protect is in-use throughout Alameda County.



Genasys Protect divides Oakland into small zones that each contain a number of streets or blocks. Zones for Oakland are named OKL-Exxx, where xxx is a 3-digit number. For example, zone OKL-E114 is an area just west of Lake Merritt.

Everyone in Oakland should know their zone name. **Zones will be used to specify which areas are to evacuate, shelter-in-place, return home, etc.** To learn your zone name, go to: **protect.genasys.com** and enter your address or locate it on the map.

Memorize your zone name, write it down and put it in a visible location, such as taped to the inside of your front door. Also know your zone for where you work or learn.



To access Genasys Protect, use your browser on a smartphone, tablet or computer and go to:

protect.genasys.com

During an emergency, Oakland's Fire/Police Departments will communicate warnings or orders for one or more zones using various means. **The primary notification will be by AC Alert--sign up for these at: www.acgov.org/emergencysite/**. Local AM/FM radio stations, social media, loud speakers, 2-way radios and even door-to-door alerts may also be used. For more information, refer to: **Guide #02 – Notifications and Warnings**

In Genasys Protect, click on your (or any other) zone to view its current status: EVACUATION ORDER - leave now! EVACUATION WARNING - potential threat EVACUATION LIFTED - safe to return

NORMAL - no knowledge of threats

SHELTER-IN-PLACE - go indoors and stay

EMERGENCY EVACUATIONS

All Oakland residents, workers and students need to be prepared for an emergency evacuation. A fire, flood or tsunami could affect a large part of the City. A wind-driven firestorm could devastate Oakland from the Hills all the way to the Bay.
